STUDY SESSION

2. Potential Ballot Measures for November 2024 - Results From Community Survey and Council Direction
Christina Horrisberger, Assistant City Manager; Barry Barnes, TeamCivX; and Timothy McLarney, True North Research gave the presentation.

Public Comment: Michael Ragan spoke in opposition to a ballot measure to revisit Measure Y. Jordan Grimes expressed concerns for this ballot measure not addressing the city's housing needs.

Council majority provided direction to staff to: proceed with education and outreach on the land use measure and return to the Council for a decision whether to place it on the November 2024 ballot; to not proceed with education and outreach on the Charter amendments measures and return to Council for a decision whether to place them on the November 2024 ballot. Council provided feedback on staff's education and information outreach plan and gave direction to include the phrase "without raising taxes" to clarify that there is no tax increase related to the November 2024 ballot measure.
