**APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT TO  
EXPEND THE OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS  
TOTALING \$200,000**

WHEREAS, the Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) has awarded the City a grant totaling \$200,000 through its Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) for local law enforcement traffic control/safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, OTS requires that recipient cities adopt resolutions to appropriate funds, which would be reimbursed through the grant, and authorize the expenditure of STEP grant monies.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

1. This action is not a project subject to CEQA, because it can be seen with certainty that it will not cause a physical change in the environment (Public Resources Code Section 21065).
2. The appropriation of \$200,000 in Selective Traffic Enforcement Program grant funds to the police grant fund budget is approved.
3. The grant spending plan is approved, and the Chief of Police is authorized to accept and execute the Office of Traffic Safety Selective Traffic Enforcement Program grant agreement and to expend the Office of Traffic Safety Selective Traffic Enforcement Program grant funds for traffic control/safety purposes.
