General Municipal Election November 5, 2024 - Certification of Results

### RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution to declare the results of the General Municipal Election held on November 5, 2024, as presented in the Certificate and Statement of Results of Vote Cast for the City of San Mateo.

### BACKGROUND:

The City of San Mateo held its first candidate by-district election for Districts 2 and 4 on November 5, 2024; and for submitting to the Voters Measure T to approve the General Plan Land Use Element.

The number of ballots cast for a candidate in each district were District 2 – 5,703 and District 4 - 5,302. At the general municipal election held in the City of San Mateo on November 5, 2024, the following persons were elected to the following offices:

Nicole Fernandez and Danielle Cwirko-Godycki were elected as members of the City Council for terms commencing Monday, December 9, 2024. Nicole Fernandez will serve as the representative for District 2, while Danielle Cwirko-Godycki will represent District 4. Both terms will continue until the general municipal election in the fourth year thereafter and the election and qualification of their respective successors.

The number of ballots cast citywide for the ballot measure were 42,554 with 25,271 voting yes and 17,283 voting no. The ordinance approving Measure T was therefore adopted by the voters on November 5, 2024 and will go into effect ten days after certification of election results, i.e., on December 19, 2024.

### BUDGET IMPACT:

There is no budgetary impact associated with this administrative action of certifying the election results.

### ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

This resolution of adoption is not a project subject to CEQA, because it is an organizational or administrative activity that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5).)
