I am thrilled to see the city prioritizing walking & biking safety at this critical intersection in the city.

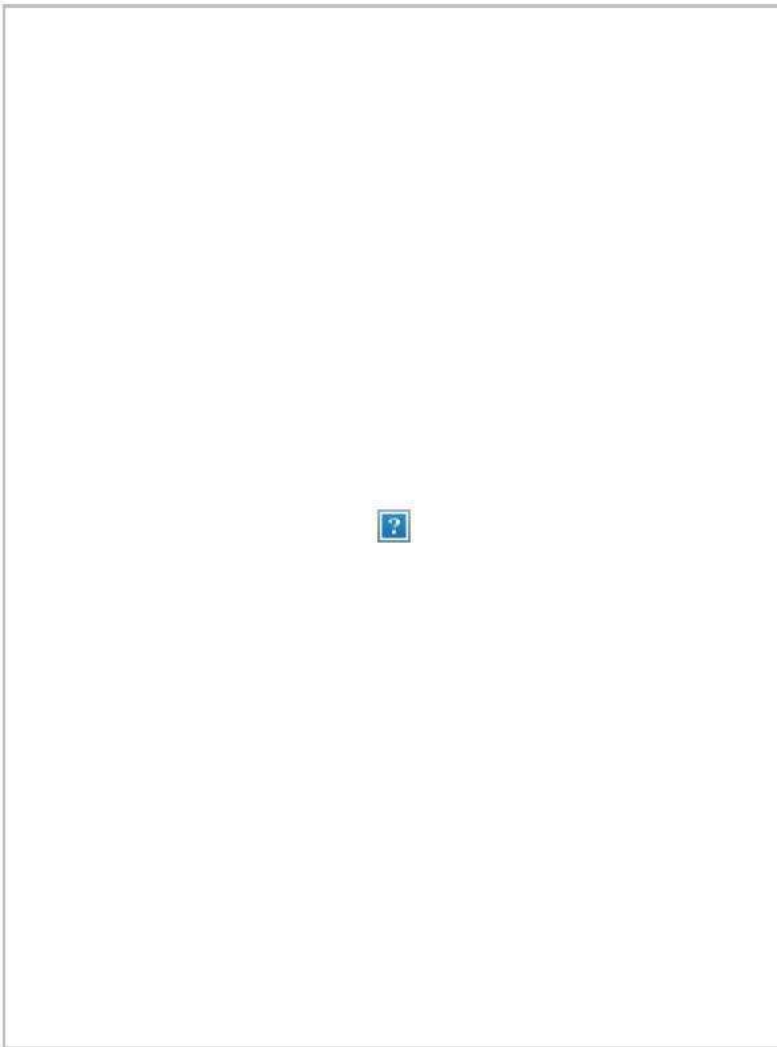
There are 5 locations that a person without a car can cross Highway 101 in the city of San Mateo:

- Peninsula
- Monte Diablo

- Fashion Island Boulevard
- Hillsdale

Few of these crossings feel pleasant or provide an impression of safety to those attempting to cross 101 without a car.

Thank you for prioritizing these safety improvements--these designed changes look great.

I say this as a resident who has walked/biked/jog this intersection countless times, occasionally in volunteering with a bike bus, ferrying children across 101 to reach Parkside Montessori:
