**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_ (2024)**

**DECLARING RESULTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION**  
**HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN MATEO ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024**

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held and conducted in the City of San Mateo (City) on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, as required by law and the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held for the purpose of electing two (2) persons as City Council members for four-year terms, one each from Districts 2 and 4; and for the purpose of submitting Measure T to the qualified electors; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and legally given, voting precincts were properly established, and election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished. In all respects said election was held and conducted, and the votes cast at the election were received and canvassed, and the returns thereof were made, determined and declared in time, form and manner as required by the City Charter and the general laws of the State providing for and regulating municipal elections in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City met at Council Chambers on Monday, December 9, 2024 as required by Charter to canvass the returns of said election, install the newly elected Council members, and to elect the Mayor and Deputy Mayor;

WHEREAS, said canvass was duly completed and the results thereof are as hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY DETERMINES AND RESOLVES THAT:

1. The general municipal election was held and conducted in the City of San Mateo, County of San Mateo, State of California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, in the time and in the form and manner as required by law.
2. A canvass of the return of the votes cast in the City of San Mateo for the office of City Council members for Districts 2 and 4 was duly held on December 5, 2024, with the final official results, in accordance with the order of the Council, pursuant to the Charter and law, after certification by the Clerk of the County of San Mateo, and Martin H. McTaggart, City Clerk of San Mateo.
3. The total number of votes cast regarding Measure T, which was a Ballot Measure to increase certain limits on building heights, residential densities, and nonresidential building intensities previously enacted by the voters, was 42,554 with 25,271 voting “yes”, and 17,283 voting “no” as set forth in the Certificate attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. The Ordinance approving Measure T was therefore adopted by the voters on November 5, 2024, and Measure T is accordingly enacted. This Resolution shall serve as the date of certification of election results by the City Council for purposes of determining the effective date of Measure T.

4. The total number of votes cast for Council members in the City of San Mateo at said election was 5,703 in District 2; 5,302 in District 4.

- a. The names of the persons voted for, the offices for which they were voted, the number of votes received by each of the persons in each of said precincts, together with the total number of votes, which they received by District, are shown on the Certificate attached as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference.

- b. At said general municipal election held in the City of San Mateo on November 5, 2024, the following persons were elected to the following offices:

NICOLE FERNANDEZ was elected a member of the City Council for District 2 for a term commencing Monday, December 9, 2024, and until the general municipal election the fourth year thereafter and the election and qualification of a successor.

DANIELLE CWIRKO-GODYCKI was elected a member of the City Council for District 4 for a term commencing Monday, December 9, 2024, and until the general municipal election the fourth year thereafter and the election and qualification of a successor

5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to produce and deliver to each of the persons elected a certificate of election signed by him and duly authenticated.
6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to enter into the records of the City of San Mateo a statement of the results of said general election.
