Park and Recreation Commission Youth Commissioner – Reappointment

RECOMMENDATION:

Reappoint Thomas Jacob Jelniker as a Youth Commissioner to the Park and Recreation Commission for one additional one-year term, expiring November 6, 2025.

BACKGROUND:

Thomas Jacob Jelniker was appointed to the Park and Recreation Commission as a Youth Commissioner on November 6, 2023. Youth Commissioner Jelniker's term is scheduled to expire on November 6, 2024, and he has expressed a preference to serve an additional one-year term.

In accordance with Municipal Code Section 2.27.010 "Youth Commissioners may be reappointed for one additional one-year term." In addition, at the time of appointment, Youth Commissioners must be at least 13 years old, and no more than 17 years old. Youth Commissioner Jelniker will be 17 at the time of reappointment and is therefore eligible for a one-year reappointment as a Youth Commissioner to the Parks and Recreation Commission.

Early this year, Audrey Li vacated her position on the Commission, prompting recruitment for this role will commence in early 2025.
