# Community Development

## CDBG Priority Neighborhood:

- Street rehabilitation and pedestrian safety project is in the design phase
- Construction expected to begin Winter 19-20

## Public Facilities Grant:

- CORA safe house project completed, accessibility upgrades to a restroom

# Community Funding Program

- ◆ Public Services:
  - ◆ Seven agencies awarded \$14,400 each
  - ◆ Served 2,242 unduplicated individuals
- ◆ Minor Home Repair:
  - ◆ Four grants to three agencies
  - ◆ 33 homes received a wide variety of repairs
- ◆ Economic Development
  - ◆ One grant assisted 34 people, including 15 San Mateo businesses
- ◆ Fair Housing:
  - ◆ One grant to Project Sentinel served 23 clients
