

**CITY OF SAN MATEO
RESOLUTION NO. ____ (2019)**

APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 LOCAL SOLICITATION TO PURCHASE LAW ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the US Department of Justice (DOJ), Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program provides funding to state and local government to support projects that improve or enhance law enforcement programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Mateo is eligible to receive an allocation of \$18,176 from the JAG program for 2019; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo Police Department has proposed to use its 2019 allocation to purchase law enforcement equipment for use by its Specialist Officer Team; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Mateo will need to contribute approximately \$4,450 from its 2019/2020 general fund operating budget to fully fund the purchase of the desired equipment; and

WHEREAS, the grant application has been made available to the City Council and to the public for a period of 30 days preceding this meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SAN MATEO CITY COUNCIL HEREBY FINDS and RESOLVES that:

1. The City Manager or his designee, on behalf of the City of San Mateo, is authorized to submit an application for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program to the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for \$18,176 to purchase law enforcement equipment – 2019-DJ-BX-0220.
2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute in the name of the City of San Mateo, the application and any documents required by the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the JAG program related to the acceptance of the grant funds.
3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized, if said grant is awarded, to accept and appropriate the \$18,176 to the Police Grants fund.
