**CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN UNITED AGAINST HATE WEEK**

WHEREAS, United Against Hate Week was started by the Mayor of Berkeley in 2017 and is a call for seven days of local civic action by people in every Bay Area community to stop the "hate and the implicit biases that are a threat to the safety and civility of our neighborhoods, towns and cities;" and

WHEREAS, in 2019, United Against Hate Week will be held November 17th through 23rd; and

WHEREAS, there is widespread support in the East Bay for United Against Hate Week, and the sponsors are now seeking to widen its reach by asking communities in San Mateo County to adopt resolutions of support, post signs, and host events; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is not a project subject to CEQA, because it can be seen with certainty that it will not cause a physical change in the environment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Mateo supports and will participate in United Against Hate Week.
