**APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR LICENSING AND MAINTENANCE AND  
SUPPORT SERVICES FOR EDEN ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING SOFTWARE**

WHEREAS, the City uses Tyler Technologies, Inc.'s Eden enterprise resource planning software for financial, payroll, and human resources functions that are essential to City operations; and

WHEREAS, the City's information technology department relies on Tyler Technologies for maintenance and support services to ensure the Eden software is fully functional and operational; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 3.60.070(h)(3) provides that the City may use any purchasing procedures approved by the City Council if the Council makes a finding concurrent with the award for the contract that the procedures are in the best interest of the City for the particular contract; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Municipal Code section 3.60.050 (b) calling for competitive bids would be unavailing because Tyler Technologies Inc. is the sole provider of the city's enterprise resource planning software; and

WHEREAS, this purchase is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act in that it can be seen with certainty that it will have no significant impact on the physical environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY FINDS and RESOLVES that:

1. Pursuant to Municipal Code section 3.60.070 (h)(3), the agreement with Tyler Technologies for licensing and maintenance support services is in the City's best interest because Eden software is required to support essential City operations;
2. Pursuant to Municipal Code section 3.60.050(b) calling for bids is impracticable and would be unavailing because Tyler Technologies is the sole provider of maintenance and support services for Eden software;
3. The purchase of a one-year maintenance agreement from Tyler Technologies, Inc. in the amount of \$109,030.99 is approved;
4. The Director of the Department of Information Technology is authorized to execute the agreement in substantially the form submitted, on behalf of the City.
