**ADOPTION OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO'S 2020 BICYCLE MASTER PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of San Mateo previously adopted a Bicycle Master Plan in 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Mateo was awarded a Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 grant to complete an update of the prior 2011 Bicycle Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Bicycle Master Plan was developed collaboratively by working with City departments, City Council, the Sustainability and Infrastructure Commission, resident advisory members, and community engagement; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Bicycle Master Plan encompasses an evaluation of the current bicycle network, data analysis of the City's bicycle infrastructure needs, identification of a complete and safe bicycle circulation network, recommendations for support programs and policies, and a comprehensive prioritized project list including estimated costs, opportunities for short-term implementation, and a funding strategy; and,

WHEREAS, an environmental review of the 2020 Bicycle Master Plan determined the Plan is categorically exempt from CEQA because all proposed projects are located within the public right-of-way. (CEQA Guidelines Section 15304 (h)); and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), adoption of the 2020 Bicycle Master Plan is exempt from CEQA review under the "common sense" exemption because it is adoption of a Plan only. The individual projects in the Plan are not yet funded, and each project will require a separate CEQA analysis at time of design and construction; and,

WHEREAS, the Sustainability and Infrastructure Commission has recommended the City Council adopt the 2020 Bicycle Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, staff is recommending the City Council adopt the 2020 Bicycle Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

1. The City Council of the City of San Mateo hereby adopts the City of San Mateo's 2020 Bicycle Master Plan.
