



## Health Order Update

- July 13<sup>th</sup>: Governor orders statewide shutdown
  - Indoor dining at restaurants
    - Outside dining still allowed
  - Movie theaters/family entertainment centers
  - Wineries/tasting rooms (indoor)

- Parks and Recreation
  - Second session of Summer Camps began today
  - Working with SMFC School District to support child care and distance learning for new school year
  - Planning to bring amendment to Par3 contract to Council in August

## **Operational Update**


- Library
  - New "Virtual Summer Fair" July 6<sup>th</sup> through 31st
  - Virtual Art Exhibit available online from July 1st through August 31st
  - Planning for family story times in San Mateo parks

- Police Department
  - Parking enforcement resumed on July  $15^{\rm th}$ 
    - Downtown meters/pay stations, street sweeping, RPPP
    - Not enforcing 2-hour zones outside of RPPP zones

### Operational Update Public Works

#### Safe Streets Initiative

- North Central:
  - Removed original locations
  - Revised locations:
    - Grant Monte Diablo to 2<sup>nd</sup>
    - Claremont Poplar to Tilton
- Central:
  - Removed Fremont between Monte Diablo and 5<sup>th</sup>
  - Fremont between 5<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> remains
- Bay Meadows:
  - More turn restriction signs installed on Saratoga & Delaware

Provided 2,182 local businesses with more than \$240M, which allowed them to retain more than 24,000+ jobs.


 21 grants to childcare programs (over \$1.1M)
