**APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE  
ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 LOCAL SOLICITATION TO PURCHASE LAW  
ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the US Department of Justice (DOJ), Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program provides funding to state and local government to support projects that improve or enhance law enforcement programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Mateo is eligible to receive an allocation of \$17,062 from the JAG program for 2020; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo Police Department has proposed to use its 2020 allocation for training and to purchase Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) for police patrol vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the grant application has been made available to the City Council and to the public for a period of 30 days preceding this meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SAN MATEO CITY COUNCIL HEREBY FINDS and RESOLVES that:

1. The City Manager or his designee, on behalf of the City of San Mateo, is authorized to submit an application for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program to the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for \$17,062 to purchase law enforcement equipment – 2020-H9051-CA-DJ.
2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute in the name of the City of San Mateo, the application and any documents required by the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the JAG program related to the acceptance of the grant funds.
3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized, if said grant is awarded, to accept and appropriate the \$17,062 to the Police Grants fund.
