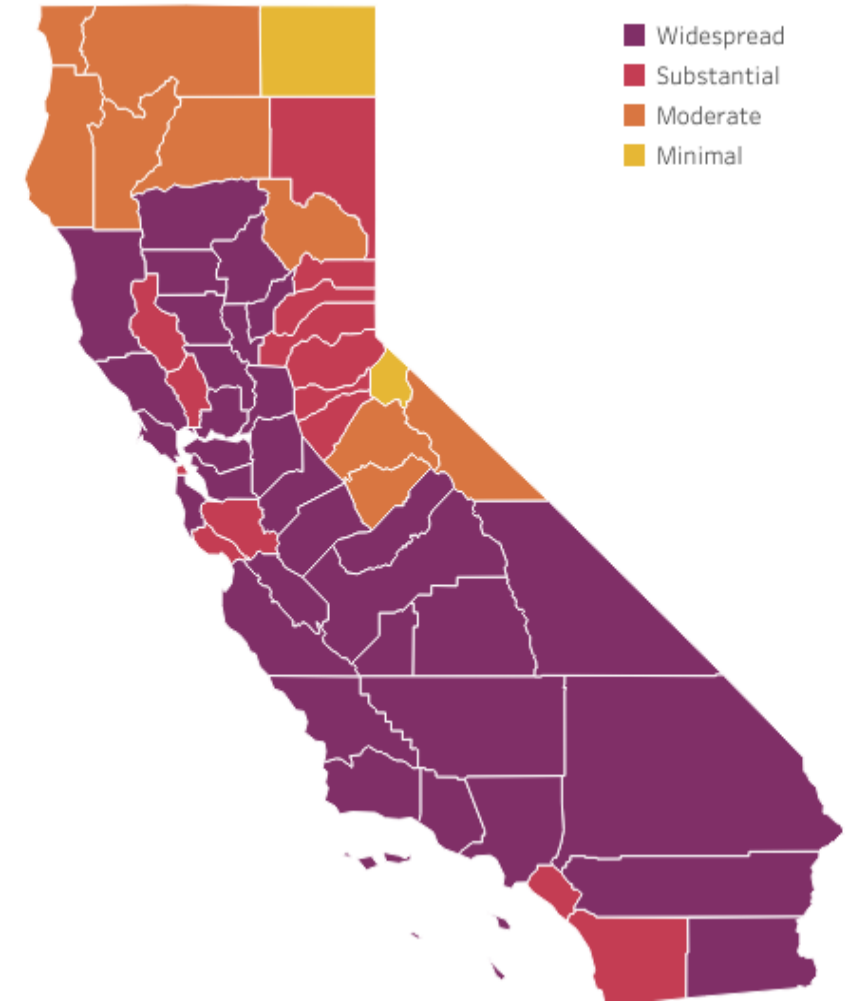

# Health Order Update

- August 31<sup>st</sup>: New State framework
  - “Blueprint for a Safer Economy”
    - Tiered ranking system for counties based on case count and positivity rate
    - San Mateo currently in Purple Tier 1
      - Widespread risk
  - Hair salons/barbershops allowed indoors with modifications
    - Nail salons cannot operate indoors
  - Shopping centers allowed indoors at 25% capacity

# Health Order Update

- San Mateo County - Purple Tier
  - To move to Red Tier (Substantial)
    - < 7 daily new cases per 100K AND < 8% test positivity rate for two consecutive weeks
    - As of 8/31: 7.7 daily new cases/5.2% positivity rate
    - Meet State-identified health equity measures
- Majority of California in Purple Tier



# Operational Update

- Parks and Recreation
  - Support for distance learning
    - Full-day program at King Center operating since August 17th
      - Currently serving 50 children, including 20 PAL families
      - Expanding capacity at King Center by 14 and 24 at the Senior Center
      - Exploring collaboration with Library for staffing resources/special programs
      - Tutoring services provided through the financial support of PAL
      - SMFCSD will provide breakfast/lunch for anyone under 18 who is in need

# Operational Update

- Parks and Recreation
  - New rules requiring permits for groups greater than 5 at parks has been generally effective
    - Permit use for youth sports taking some of weekend capacity
  - Certain park amenities still closed based on State health orders
    - Playgrounds, group picnic areas
  - Issued 5 permits for private outdoor fitness programs with one still outstanding

# Operational Update

- City Manager's Office
  - Coordinating with County on mobile COVID-19 testing site in North Central
    - Targeted specifically for neighborhood residents
    - Working with HANCSM to secure location and coordinate communication and outreach plan
    - Date and time still pending
  - Coordinating with CDD, PW, and PD to address some safety concerns with parklets
    - Developing construction guidelines for built parklets and designing safety upgrades
    - Requiring some businesses to modify built parklets
