**CITY’S PARTICIPATION IN UNITED AGAINST HATE WEEK**

WHEREAS, United Against Hate Week was started by the Mayor of Berkeley in 2017 and is a call for seven days of local civic action by people in every Bay Area community to stop the “hate and the implicit biases that are a threat to the safety and civility of our neighborhoods, towns and cities;” and

WHEREAS, in 2020, United Against Hate Week will be held November 30th through December 6th; and

WHEREAS, **the City of San Mateo participated in United Against Hate Week in 2019 and wishes to continue our support and participation in the event** by adopting a resolution of support, posting signs throughout the community, and hosting events; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is not a project subject to CEQA, because it can be seen with certainty that it will not cause a physical change in the environment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Mateo supports and will participate in United Against Hate Week.
