APPROPRIATE \$67,976 OF PROPERTY OWNER REPAYMENTS TO EMERGENCY TENANT RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PROJECT

WHEREAS, Section 5.13(a) of the City Charter requires Council approval by resolution for supplemental appropriations to the City's budget; and

WHEREAS, the adopted 2020-21 budget appropriated \$50,000 of the General Fund Housing Reserve into project 313134 to provide an emergency relocation assistance fund for renters who must move from their homes due to unsafe occupancy issues as determined by Code Enforcement; and

WHEREAS, in fiscal year 2020-21, the City received reimbursement payments in the amount of \$67,976 from property owners for funds the City fronted to assist tenants in emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this appropriation is to deposit the repayments back into the project for use in the future as a revolving fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

- 1. A supplemental budget appropriation to the Emergency Tenant Relocation Assistance Project 313134 received from property owner repayments for fiscal year 2020-21 is approved in the amount of \$67,976.
- 2. In accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4), this appropriation is not a project subject to CEQA because it is a government fiscal activity that will not impact the environment.
