**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM
OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN MATEO AND THE SAN MATEO COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR THE US 101/PENINSULA AVENUE INTERCHANGE PROJECT –
PROJECT APPROVAL ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT PHASE**

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2016, the City of San Mateo (City) and the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (TA) entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (original MOU) to complete the Project Approval Environmental Document (PAED) phase of the US-101/Peninsula Avenue Interchange Project; and

WHEREAS, the MOU defines the scope of work, funding and payment, terms, and responsibilities for the City and the TA; and

WHEREAS, since the original MOU approval in 2016, the TA has been overseeing the work necessary to complete the PAED phase of the project, including the administration of consultant services related to the study; and

WHEREAS, the consultant's contract with the TA expired and the new agreement resulted in an increased project cost due to updated consultant billing rates, a change in scope of work to accommodate more public outreach than originally anticipated, and a longer project schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City is paying for the cost increase and a new MOU is needed to establish the modified terms of the funding commitment and new project timeline; and

WHEREAS, the new MOU includes provisions for the City to provide \$600,000 for a new cost for the PAED phase of \$3.1 million; and

WHEREAS, as part of the 2020-21 capital improvement budget, the City already allocated \$600,000 to the US-101/Peninsula Interchange Project account to cover the anticipated increase in costs; and

WHEREAS, the new MOU has a project scope of work completion date of June 30, 2022 and a termination date of December 31, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

1. The Memorandum of Understanding with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority for the Project Approval Environmental Document phase for the US-101/Peninsula Avenue Interchange Project is approved.
2. The City Manager is authorized to sign the Memorandum of Understanding.
