# Health/Vaccine Update

- Vaccination efforts continue
  - 85% of SMC residents 16+ have at least one dose of vaccine
  - 83% of SMC residents 12+ have at least one dose of vaccine
- State set to lift most COVID-19 restrictions on June 15<sup>th</sup>
  - No physical distancing requirements
  - No capacity limits indoors or outdoors
  - Masking guidelines to align with CDC



# Operational Update

- City Hall operations
  - Targeting return to (close to) normal operations July 1st
    - City Hall to resume normal operations to the public on June 15th
    - Will still meet CalOSHA regulations for having more people in the office
    - Many office employees will still have some sort of hybrid schedule
- In person City Council meetings
  - Testing technology for hybrid in person/remote meetings
  - Governor's order waiving certain Brown Act requirements, including a quorum of Council on site, still in effect



# Operational Update

- Parks and Recreation
  - Beresford and King Centers to re-open to the public on June 15
  - Senior Center to begin limited in-person programs July 8
  - Added weekend afternoon rec swim-Saturday @ Joinville; Sunday @ King Pool
  - Summer camps and programs begin June 21
  - Limited Central Park Music Series begins July 4
    - 5 total events, no pre-registration needed
  - Free use of park space for indoor gyms will end June 30
    - May still apply under normal park permit process as a private business



# Operational Update

- Library
  - Expand all locations to 75% of pre-pandemic operational hours on July 6
    - Main will return to 7-day schedule; branches open 6 days/week
    - Aim for 100% service restoration by first week of September
  - In addition to current offerings, expanded services include:
    - Small study rooms open with a maximum capacity of 2 people per room
    - Computer use for 3 hours per day
    - Seating without time-limits for study, reading, WiFi use, etc.
  - All spaces will be open at the Main Library except:
    - Computer lab for classes
    - Community meeting rooms, except for limited library programs



# Council Confirmation

- Council confirmation for actions to be taken in response to the emergency proclamation
  - Phased “return to normal” plans for Parks and Recreation, City Hall, and Library operations
