

**CITY OF SAN MATEO
RESOLUTION NO. 79 (2021)**

**APPROPRIATE \$153,000 IN MEASURE A AND W FUNDS AND AUTHORIZE A BUDGET TRANSFER OF \$17,000 TO
THE HILLSDALE CALTRAIN STATION BICYCLE ACCESS GAP CLOSURE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2020, the San Mateo County Transportation Authority released a Call for Projects for grant funding from the Measure A and W Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funding; and

WHEREAS, at the October 19, 2020 City Council meeting, Council adopted a resolution to authorize an application with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority for the Measure A and W Pedestrian and Bicycle Program for the Hillside Caltrain Station Bicycle Access Gap Closure project; and

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2020, the San Mateo County Transportation Authority Board of Directors approved an award of \$153,000 in Measure A and W grant funding for the Hillside Caltrain Station Gap Closure project; and

WHEREAS, staff proposed allocating Measure A Local Streets and Transportation funds to fulfill the local match in the FY2021-22 budget; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4), this fund transfer and appropriation is categorically exempt from CEQA as a fiscal activity and this project is identified in the 2020 Bicycle Master Plan, which was determined to be Categorical Exempt under CEQA per Section 15304 Minor Alterations to Land – Class 4, Subsection (h).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, FINDS and RESOLVES that:

1. Appropriate \$153,000 in Measure A and W grant funding from the San Mateo County Transportation Authority Pedestrian and Bicycle Program and transfer \$17,000 in Measure A Local Streets and Transportation Funds to Project #46m004.
