

**CITY OF SAN MATEO
RESOLUTION NO. ____ (2021)**

**AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,477.52 OF FEDERAL GRANT FUNDING FOR THE
TRAIN QUIET ZONE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Train Quiet Zone project includes efforts to minimize train horn noise impacts and includes planning activities for the 4th and 5th Avenue Grade Crossing Improvement projects (Projects) to install safety improvements at these locations; and

WHEREAS, work on the Projects is funded by the Railroad-Highway Grade Crossing Program – Section 130 by reimbursement, approved by the California Public Utility Commission (CPUC) and administered through the California State Department of Transportation (Caltrans); and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2020, City Council adopted a resolution to approve funding agreements with Caltrans for the Projects for the Preliminary Engineering Phase; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans approved reimbursement in the amount of \$10,477.52 expended on the Train Quiet Zone project (#462205) for staff time spent on planning and design of the Projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

1. The Council authorizes the appropriation of \$10,477.52 of federal grant funding to be received from the Railroad-Highway Grade Crossing Program to the Train Quiet Zone project (#462205).
