

**CITY OF SAN MATEO
RESOLUTION NO. 78 (2021)**

ADOPT A RESOLUTION TO RESTATE THE GANN APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22

WHEREAS, Article XIII-B of the California State Constitution provides limits regarding the total amount of appropriations in any fiscal year from “the proceeds of taxes”; and

WHEREAS, a calculation error was found in the previously adopted Fiscal Year 2021-22 appropriations limit, and the revised appropriations limit is \$234,724,213; and

WHEREAS, the estimated budgeted proceeds from taxes that are subject to the limitation for this fiscal year is \$106,611,897, which is \$128,112,316 under the revised appropriation limit for Fiscal Year 2021-22; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

1. The revised appropriations limit for fiscal year 2021-22 is \$234,724,213.
