**APPROVING THE DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM AND APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING  
EXECUTION OF THE RELATED IMPLEMENTATION AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, agencies wishing to receive federal funds for transportation projects through the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) must implement a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program in accordance with Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations; and

WHEREAS, a 2007 Availability and Disparity Study conducted by Caltrans resulted in a requirement that local agencies implement a DBE program that includes a race conscious component for federally funding transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously approved and authorized execution of the implementation agreement in May 2009; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans requires a new implementation agreement to be signed periodically as Caltrans updates its DBE Program Plan language;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

1. The City Council approves the related Implementation Agreement ("California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Implementation Agreement" dated September 2020).
2. The Public Works Director is authorized to sign and execute said Implementation Agreement in substantially the form attached on behalf of the City.
