

# Downtown Parking Policy Update Comprehensive Fee Schedule Amendment

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### **Background**



Kiku Crossing project construction at 4th and Claremont/5th and Claremont parking lots



These lots currently offer low-cost parking options

\$0.25/hour \$40/month



Intended to serve low-wage workers



Provides opportunity to re-evaluate how to achieve goals



### **Maintain Low-Cost Parking Options**

#### **Low-Cost Monthly Permit**

- Current low-cost permits are first-come, first-served at specific locations
- Staff proposes offering a low-cost \$40 permit at any facility
  - Qualifications for purchase makes permits available to those who need them
  - Staff will allocate 10% of permits at each facility to start; will monitor demand and adjust as needed to ensure availability

#### **Low-Cost Hourly Parking**

- Claremont lots currently offer low-cost hourly parking
- \$0.25 per hour parking not offered in other locations
- Staff proposes reducing the hourly rate at South Railroad Ave. to continue to offer this option




# Premium Parking Zone

Intent: Incentivize parking at perimeter locations and walking through Downtown

Main Street Garage is included in perimeter 'Value' zone

Downtown San Mateo developed in a way that Main Street Garage is now a central facility

Staff proposes to adjust parking rates to align with land use and meet goals of parking program



#### Recommendation

# Low-Cost Hourly Parking

Reduce hourly parking rate on South Railroad

## Low-Cost Permit Program

 Introduce a \$40 permit option for qualifying individuals at all facilities

## Align Premium Parking Zone

- Add Main Street Garage to Premium parking zone
- Rates increase to \$1.25/hour and \$100/month

#### Recommendation

Adopt a Resolution to amend the Adopted 2021-22 Comprehensive Fee Schedule to Revise Downtown Parking Pass Fees and Hourly Parking Fees.

### **Future Considerations**

- Construction at surface parking lots temporarily reduces parking supply by 235 spaces
- Staff will monitor parking demand and utilization
- If indicated, other supply options will be considered
  - Valet parking
  - Leased private parking
  - Additional 10-hour parking spaces
