2. <u>Alameda de las Pulgas and Portola Drive Cal Water Pump Station Replacement Project – Special Use Permit, Site Plan and Architectural Review, and Variance (PA-2020-052</u>

3. Housing Element Update Process

Housing Manager Sandy Council presented an informational update on the status of the City's Housing Element update, including a summary of the document, description of the process, timeline and workshops planned in the future.

Commissioner Questions: Commissioners had questions about the purpose of housing element goals and zoning accommodations for current and future housing cycles; requested clarification on the critetia and methodology used for the sites inventory and fair housing compliance; and requested clarification about the Regional Housing Needs Allocations (RHNA) criteria, definitions, past progress and zoning capacity as it pertains to affordability goals.

Public Comments: Raayan had questions on housing cycles and zoning capacities, and commented that increased densities should be considered to reduce greenhouse gas emissions; Chris Giotinis commented that Measure Y has negatively impacted the ability of housing projects to add extra floors; Jordan Grimes commented that he was concerned about the City's ability to meet its RHNA with current zoning and the restrictions of Measure Y.
