

**CITY OF SAN MATEO  
RESOLUTION NO. 14 (2022)**

**AUTHORIZING A BUDGET TRANSFER OF \$95,000 FROM THE HIGH VOLTAGE STREET LIGHT CONVERSION  
PROJECT TO THE CITYWIDE STREET REHABILITATION PACKAGE 2 PROJECT FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the Citywide Street Rehabilitation Package 2-B project is funded by Citywide Street Rehabilitation Package 2 budget (Project No. 467008); and

WHEREAS, High Voltage Street Light Conversion Project elements are included in the Citywide Street Rehabilitation Package 2-B project; and

WHEREAS, funding from the appropriate budget is needed to cover the street light portion of the project; and

WHEREAS, \$95,000 of High Voltage Street Light Conversion Project No. 460040 budget is available to be transferred to the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

1. Environmental review is not required because this transfer of budget funds is a government fiscal activity which does not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment. (CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(4).) Additionally, the High Voltage Street Light Conversion Project and Citywide Street Rehabilitation Project 2 are categorically exempt as existing facilities which consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. (CEQA Guidelines sections 15301.)
2. A budget transfer of \$95,000 to the Citywide Street Rehabilitation Package 2 Project from the High Voltage Street Light Conversion Project is authorized.
