Subject: Removal of parking spots along E Poplar

Dear City Council,

I have been following the news regarding adding a bike lane and removing parking along East Poplar.

I fear the council will approve this bike lane without regard to logic. A street heading towards a major highway is not ideal. Furthermore, there are no speed controls: bumps or stops or visual signage (crosswalks.)

Please register my opposition in general, HOWEVER, if the city goes forward I hope it will provide two necessary measures to help the neighborhood:

1. striped crosswalks at Highland and East Poplar;
2. Residential parking permit with a limit of 2 cars per household. This should be provided free for the first year and a nominal fee in subsequent years.

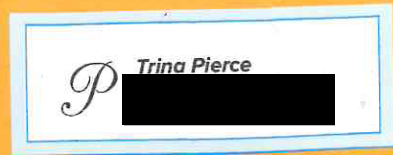
Be mindful that creating an unprotected bike lane won't stop accidents or increase safety. Crosswalks and Other measures to slow traffic will help safety. In addition I find it concerning that the major support comes from neighborhoods other than North Central (which is largely firmly opposed.) other neighborhoods have nothing to lose. We have the most impacted living area and parking: the most to lose and the least to give! It is clearly a silent and force gentrification and total disservice to our community. There are better streets where this same program can be accomplished.

Finally, we feel there has been a lack of full disclosure on the plans. Will this program look like the street running along Beresford park (28th Ave?) Can a visual be provided?

Why was no parking removed along 28th? The street is of equal width to E Poplar.

Why not put the bike lane on E Bellevue heading to the high school?? This is a quieter and safer street overall, with less parking impact. This street is a pleasure to bike.

Safety Issue for Mothers with Small Children

One of the reasons I am against this parking removal is safety. If parking spots are removed close from my home, you are now asking me, a mother of three small children (all under five) to scour for parking that is located further from my house. If I come home at a time when parking is scarce, my neighborhood will no longer be safe to me. Please imagine a mother, having to not only worry about her three children, but be more aware of her surroundings, possibly in the dark, while distracted by three children, and an arm full of groceries. Thoughts occur- will I be mugged, will a vehicle hit my child, will a bicyclist speed straight into my child? Yet, you as a city councilmember, are making my fear a reality.

Liability to Those Injured by Speeding Vehicles on E. Poplar Ave.

The only issue I have had to contend while living here are the speedy and somewhat noisy number of cars that drive by. I am aware that I live on a busy street. Those speeding vehicles are hastily making their way to the 101 freeway or El Camino. Therefore, I certainly have concern over the safety of pedestrians who will be walking home and/or the number of bicyclists using the roads, if the parking spots are removed.

Those that are Disabled will now Further be Disadvantaged

Those most vulnerable in our communities will be impacted by the removal of parking spaces. It seems like the City of San Mateo only cares about those who are affluent or capable, rather than protecting the disabled or elderly of my community. How many of those bicyclists who speak at the council meetings live on E. Poplar? How many of them are disabled?

Please consider other solutions to the biking lane measure, rather than the possible millions of dollars already spent to approve this bike lane project.

I'm reaching out to express my concerns about the NC Bike Lane Project that will be discussed on Tuesday. My concerns are:

- parking will be taken from neighbors almost immediately without proper parking alternatives being placed beforehand (blocking a driveway/parking in a random lot will NOT work for safety reasons)
- lack of inclusion of NC Residents (low-income, elder, ESL residents, and differently abled) in making these decisions
- overall safety of our neighborhood (it will benefit cyclists/pedestrians and only between peak hours)

From my understanding, we only have a certain amount of time to use the funding before we lose it. However, as the Bike Lane Project stands, it needs a lot of work. First it needs better data that includes those voices of concerned neighbors that are directly affected by these changes. And secondly, adding street/sidewalk improvements on the streets that will be even more congested than they already are due to the addition of the Bike Lanes (monte diablo, grant, tilton, etc.).

As a long time North Central resident I have witnessed countless accidents on my corner of E. Santa Inez and N. Humboldt, I have urged and asked about putting a stop sign there. Along with many other neighbors, we have asked for safety measures and general upkeep of our neighborhood with no action taken by the City. I urge you to please consider making these dire improvements of our streets and neighborhood BEFORE implementing bike lanes, or at least have it added or amended to the actual NC Bike Lane project so that we don't lose the funding and it will immediately benefit those which the CDBG is supposed to benefit in the first place.
