- 1. The deposit and withdrawal of City monies in the Local Agency Investment Fund in the State Treasury is hereby authorized in accordance with Government Code section 16429.1 et. seq. for the purpose of investment as provided therein.

The following City officers holding the title(s) specified herein below or their successors in office are each hereby authorized to order the deposit or withdrawal of monies in the Local Agency Investment Fund and may execute and deliver any and all documents necessary or advisable in order to effectuate the purposes of this resolution and the transactions contemplated hereby:
