Sign Ordinance Amendment

Update Definitions

Revise provisions addressing signs leaning against vehicles in public right-of-way

Clarify tables re minimum/maximum signage for multi-tenant buildings

Revise Chapter addressing prohibited signs to include signs in public right-of-way



Public Right-of-Way

Amendments add public right-of-way to locations where restrictions and enforcement apply

Ordinance previously defined “public property” to exclude public right-of-way

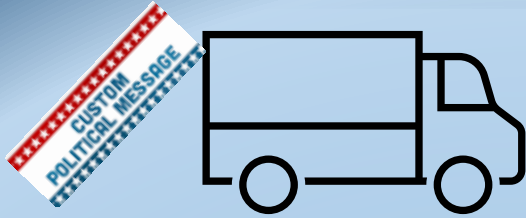
Intention was to regulate signage in public right-of-way as well

25.04.020 RESTRICTIONS APPLICABLE TO SIGNS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY AND IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this ~~chapter~~ Chapter, it is unlawful for any person other than a City representative to place a sign on public property or in the public right-of-way where such sign fails to comply with any of the restrictions stated in this section.

(b) Restrictions Applicable to Signs.





Signs on Vehicles



Clarify restrictions regarding signs on vehicles parked in public right-of-way

Signs may not be leaned against vehicles

Signs may be affixed to vehicles

(d) No person shall display a sign that would otherwise be in violation of any of the standards provided in subsections (b) and (c), by placing the sign upon, ~~attaching to,~~ or leaning ~~such~~the sign against, a vehicle parked within the a public streetright-of-way. This prohibition shall not apply to ~~vehicles upon which advertising or other messages are painted, or to signs that are signs~~ placed within the interior of ~~thea~~ vehicle, signs that are painted on a vehicle, or to signs that are affixed to a vehicle in such a manner that the vehicle may be driven with the sign attached.
