APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 LOCAL SOLICITATION TO PURCHASE LAW ENFORCEMENT CUSTOMER SERVICE SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, the US Department of Justice (DOJ), Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program provides funding to state and local government to support projects that improve or enhance law enforcement programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Mateo is eligible to receive an allocation of \$21,088 from the JAG program for 2022; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo Police Department has proposed to use its 2022 allocation to purchase law enforcement customer service software; and

WHEREAS, the grant application has been made available to the City Council and to the public for a period of 30 days preceding this meeting; and

WHEREAS, this action is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act in that it can been seen with certainty that it will have no significant impact on the physical environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, FINDS and RESOLVES that:

- 1. The Chief of Police or his designee, on behalf of the City of San Mateo, is authorized to submit an application for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program to the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for \$21,088 to purchase law enforcement customer service software O-BJA-2022-171368.
- 2. The Chief of Police or his designee is authorized to accept and execute in the name of the City of San Mateo, the application and any documents required by the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the JAG program related to the acceptance of the grant funds.
- 3. The City Council authorizes, if said grant is awarded, an appropriation of \$21,088 to the Police Grants fund.
