CITY OF SAN MATEO RESOLUTION NO. ____ (2022)

AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF 1.00 FULL TIME EQUIVALENT (FTE) POLICE OFFICER AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Police Department desires to assign a Police Officer to the San Mateo County Gun Relinquishment Task Force (GRTF) for a period of two years commencing October 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo will reimburse the City for all costs of the officer assigned to the GRTF including salary, benefits and overtime; and

WHEREAS, the assignment of an officer to the GRTF creates a vacancy in the complement of officers in the Patrol Division; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends authorization of an additional 1.00 FTE Police Officer position for a two year period to ensure no loss of service to the community, with no net financial impact as costs will be offset by reimbursement revenues received from the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.13(a) of the City Charter requires City Council approval by resolution for supplemental appropriations to the City's budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

- 1. The addition of 1.00 FTE Police Officer position is authorized for a two year period.
- 2. A budget appropriation for fiscal year 2022-23 is approved in the amount of \$167,000 for the Police Department.
