**RESOLUTION TO REORGANIZE THE EXISTING STRUCTURE OF THE POLICE ACTIVITIES LEAGUE AND
AUTHORIZE THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF (\$95,688) FROM THE POLICE
ACTIVITIES LEAGUE TO REALLOCATE A VACANT COMMUNITY SERVICES SUPERVISOR TO A
COMMUNITY SERVICES SECTION MANAGER AND TO ADD ONE ADDITIONAL FULL TIME EQUIVALENT
(FTE) COMMUNITY SERVICES COORDINATOR POSITION**

WHEREAS, staff proposes reorganizing positions assigned to the San Mateo Police Activities League ("PAL"), a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, to provide stability and greater service to the community; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the San Mateo Municipal Code Section 2.57.030(d), approval of new classifications and related job specifications, salary schedules, compensation changes, elimination or reinstatement of positions, reallocation of positions, reclassifications, and revisions of job specifications must be approved by City Council; and

WHEREAS, the employee associations representing the impacted classifications have reviewed the proposed changes and have not brought forth any objections or concerns; and

WHEREAS, additional annual costs (\$191,377) for the reorganization in excess of the City's current funding commitment will be fully reimbursed by PAL on an ongoing basis; and

WHEREAS, the proposed classification update is exempt from CEQA review because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this activity may have a significant effect on the environment. (CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3)).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that the following are approved:

1. The reallocation of 1.00 FTE vacant Community Services Supervisor to 1.00 FTE Community Services Section Manager position; and
2. The addition of 1.00 FTE Community Services Coordinator position; and
3. The appropriation of \$95,688 in funds from the General Fund, reimbursed by PAL, to cover costs for the remainder of the 2022-23 fiscal year; and
4. The City hereby accepts funding from PAL for the cost of the reorganization that will exceed the City's current funding commitment.
