AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A FUND RESERVATION AGREEMENT WITH PENINSULA CLEAN ENERGY FOR THE CITY TO RECEIVE \$54,000 TO OFFSET THE EXPENSES OF THE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGERS THAT WILL BE INSTALLED IN THE KIKU PUBLIC DOWNTOWN GARAGE AT 400 E. 5TH AVENUE AND APPROPRIATE THE FUNDS TO THE TRANSPORTATION COST CENTER OF THE DOWNTOWN SERVICES SUB FUND

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a public private partnership with MidPen Housing, Inc. to construct the Kiku Public Downtown Garage at 400 E. 5th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Kiku Public Downtown Garage will include 27 Level 2 electric vehicle chargers; and

WHEREAS, Peninsula Clean Energy is providing funding assistance in the form of \$2,000 per Level 2 electric vehicle charging port for publicly available electric vehicle chargers through a Fund Reservation Agreement under their EV Ready Program; and

WHEREAS, the \$54,000 of funding from Peninsula Clean Energy will be appropriated to the Transportation Cost Center in the Downtown Services sub fund to cover the costs of the Electric Vehicle Charger operations and maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that:

1. Appropriation of \$54,000 of funding from Peninsula Clean Energy to the Transportation Cost Center of the Downtown Services sub fund is approved.
2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a Fund Reservation Agreement with Peninsula Clean Energy for the City to receive \$54,000 to offset the expenses of the electric vehicle chargers that will be installed in the Kiku public downtown garage.
