

**CITY OF SAN MATEO
RESOLUTION NO. ____ (2022)**

**DECLARING SEMI-OFFICIAL RESULTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION
HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN MATEO ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022**

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held and conducted in the City of San Mateo (City) on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, as required by law and the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held for the purpose of electing three (3) persons as City Council members for four-year terms, one each from Districts 1, 3, and 5; and for the purpose of submitting Measure CC to the qualified electors; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and legally given, voting precincts were properly established, and election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished. In all respects said election was held and conducted, and the votes cast at the election were received and canvassed, and the returns thereof were made, determined and declared in time, form and manner as required by the City Charter and the general laws of the State providing for and regulating municipal elections in the City; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo has not yet completed its canvass of the election but has provided an Unofficial Results Report and semi-official results thereof are as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the City Council met at the Council Chambers thereof on Monday, December 5, 2022, as required by Charter to canvass the returns of said election, install the newly elected Council members, and to choose the Mayor and Deputy Mayor pending the County's completion of its canvass; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY DETERMINES and RESOLVES that:

1. The municipal election was held and conducted in the City of San Mateo, County of San Mateo, State of California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, in the time and in the form and manner as required by law.
2. A canvass of the returns of the votes cast in the City of San Mateo for the office of City Council members and with regard to Measure CC will be provided to the City Council at its December 12, 2022, meeting in accordance with the Charter and state law, after certification by the Clerk of the County of San Mateo, and Patrice M. Olds, City Clerk of San Mateo.
3. Pursuant to the County's Unofficial Results Report and semi-official results, copies of which are attached as Exhibit A, a canvass of the semi-official returns of the votes cast in the City of San Mateo for the office of City Council members and Measure CC was duly held on December 5, 2022, in accordance with the order of the Council in accordance with the Charter and law.
4. The total number of votes cast regarding MEASURE CC, which was a Ballot Measure to Increase Existing Real Property Transfer Tax Rate for Properties Sold for \$10 Million or More. At said election with 32,656 ballots cast with 23,448 voting "yes", and 9,221 voting "no" as set forth in the Certificate attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. The ordinance approving Measure CC was therefore adopted by the voters on November 8, 2022, and Measure CC is accordingly enacted.
5. The total number of votes cast for Council members in the City of San Mateo at said election was 7,550 in District 1; 5,571 in District 3; and 6,983 in District 5.

a. The names of the persons voted for, the offices for which they were voted, the number of votes received by each of the persons in each of said precincts, together with the whole number of votes, which they received by District, are shown on Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference.

b. At said general municipal election held in the City of San Mateo on November 8, 2022, the following persons were elected to the following offices:

LISA DIAZ NASH was elected a member of the City Council for District 1 for a term commencing Monday, December 5, 2022, and until the general municipal election the fourth year thereafter and the election and qualification of a successor.

ROBERT NEWSOM, JR. was elected a member of the City Council for District 3 for a term commencing Monday, December 5, 2022, and until the general municipal election the fourth year thereafter and the election and qualification of a successor.

ADAM LORAINE was elected a member of the City Council for District 5 for a term commencing Monday, December 5, 2022, and until the general municipal election the fourth year thereafter and the election and qualification of a successor.

6. As soon as the County has completed its canvass, the City Clerk is hereby directed to produce and deliver to each of the persons elected a certificate of election signed by her and duly authenticated.

7. As soon as the County has completed its canvass, the City Clerk is hereby directed to enter into the records of the City of San Mateo a statement of the results of said general municipal election.

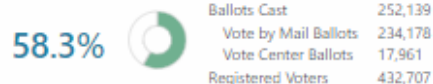
Statewide Results
