## CITY OF SAN MATEO RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_ (2022)

## DECLARING RESULTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN MATEO ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held and conducted in the City of San Mateo (City) on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, as required by law and the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held for the purpose of electing three (3) persons as City Council members for four-year terms, one each from Districts 1, 3, and 5; and for the purpose of submitting Measure CC to the qualified electors; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and legally given, voting precincts were properly established, and election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished. In all respects said election was held and conducted, and the votes cast at the election were received and canvassed, and the returns thereof were made, determined and declared in time, form and manner as required by the City Charter and the general laws of the State providing for and regulating municipal elections in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council of said City met at the Council Chambers thereof on Monday, December 5, 2022 to adopt the semi-official results with Resolution 138 (2022), as required by Charter to canvass the returns of said election, install the newly elected Council members, and to choose the Mayor and Deputy Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Council of said City met again on Monday December 12, 2022 to adopt the final official results from the County of San Mateo Elections Department, attached to this resolution as Exhibit A and replace Resolution 138 (2022) with this Resolution, and the final results of the canvass are as hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY DETERMINES and RESOLVES that:

1. The municipal election was held and conducted in the City of San Mateo, County of San Mateo, State of California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, in the time and in the form and manner as required by law.

2. A canvass of the returns of the votes cast in the City of San Mateo for the office of City Council members was duly held on December 5, 2022 with semi-official results, and again on December 12 with the final official results, in accordance with the order of the Council in accordance with the Charter and law, after certification by the Clerk of the County of San Mateo, and Patrice M. Olds, City Clerk of San Mateo.

3. The total number of votes cast regarding MEASURE CC, which was a Ballot Measure to Increase Existing Real Property Transfer Tax Rate for Properties Sold for \$10 Million or More, was 34,630 with 23,454 voting "yes", and 9,227 voting "no" as set forth in the Certificate attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. The ordinance approving Measure CC was therefore adopted by the voters on November 8, 2022, and Measure CC is accordingly enacted. This resolution shall serve as the date of certification of election results by the City Council for purposes of determining the effective date of Measure CC.

4. The total number of votes cast for Council members in the City of San Mateo at said election was 8,960 in District 1; 6,700 in District 3; and 8,417 in District 5.

a. The names of the persons voted for, the offices for which they were voted, the number of votes received by each of the persons in each of said precincts, together with the whole number of votes, which they received by District, are shown on the Certificate attached as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference.

b. At said general municipal election held in the City of San Mateo on November 8, 2022, the following persons were elected to the following offices:

LISA DIAZ NASH was elected a member of the City Council for District 1 for a term commencing Monday, December 5, 2022, and until the general municipal election the fourth year thereafter and the election and qualification of a successor.

ROBERT NEWSOM, JR. was elected a member of the City Council for District 3 for a term commencing Monday, December 5, 2022, and until the general municipal election the fourth year thereafter and the election and qualification of a successor.

ADAM LORAINE was elected a member of the City Council for District 5 for a term commencing Monday, December 5, 2022, and until the general municipal election the fourth year thereafter and the election and qualification of a successor.

6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to produce and deliver to each of the persons elected a certificate of election signed by her and duly authenticated.

7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to enter into the records of the City of San Mateo a statement of the results of said general municipal election.

8. This resolution supersedes Resolution 138 (2022).
