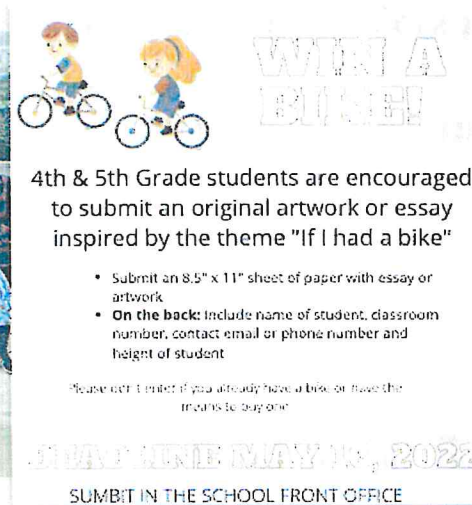

Bike Giveaway - we gave 15 bikes away at 3 schools in 2022

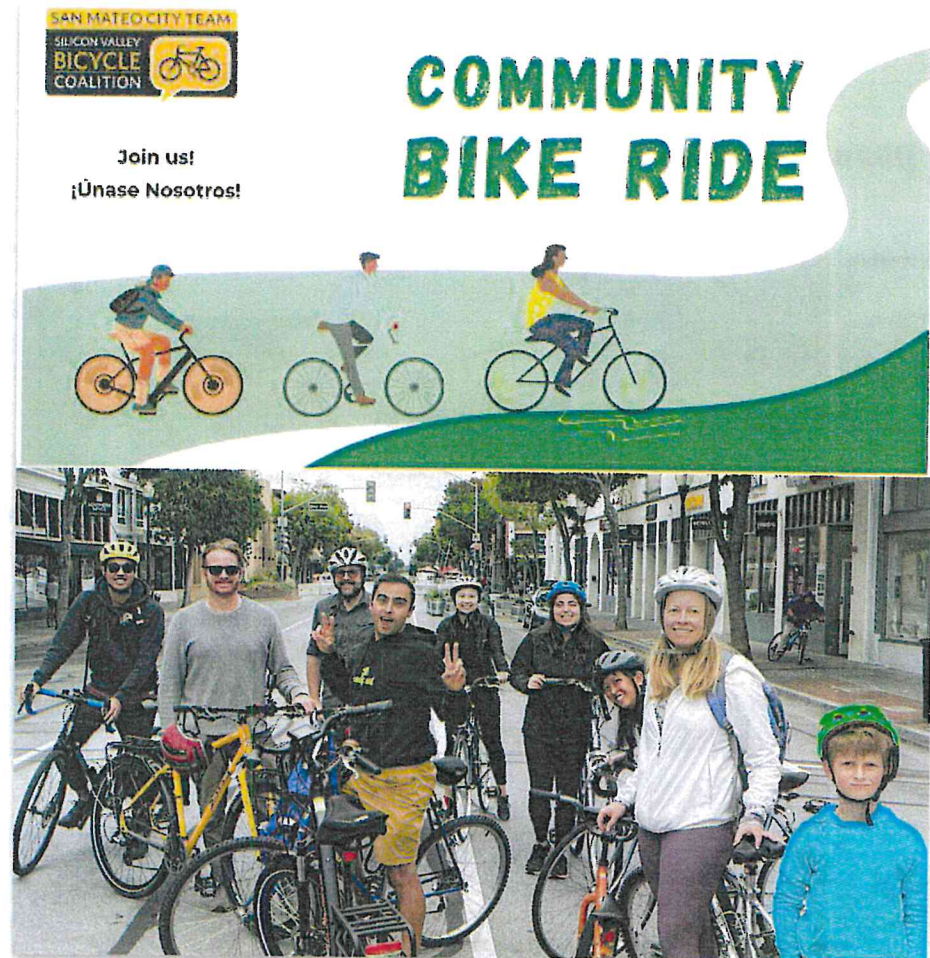

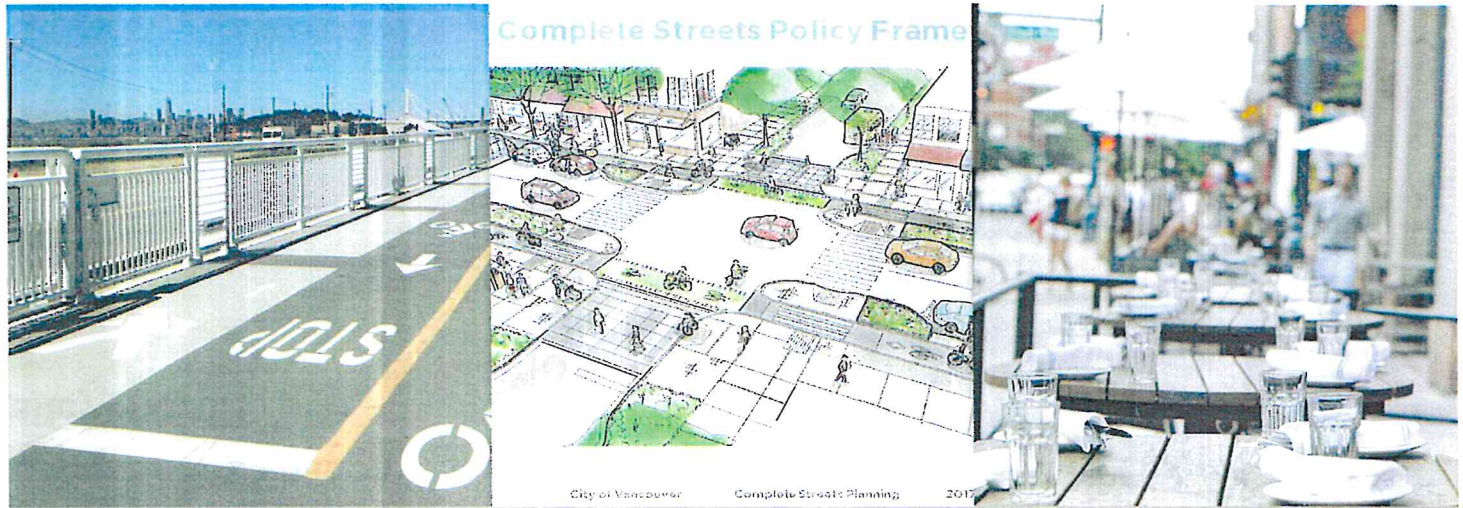
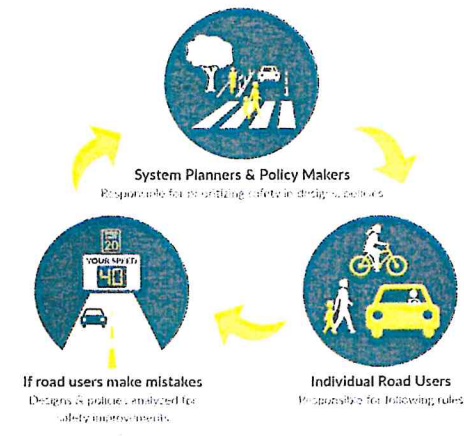

Fulfilling the City's Master Plans

Set an aggressive timeline to build the:

- Pedestrian Master Plan
- TOD Pedestrian Access Plan
- Bicycle Master Plan

Resource Evaluation: Evaluate funding & staffing needs to meet the timeline.



1 Quick-Build/Pilot Project in Each of the 5 Districts

Benefits of pilots and quick-builds:

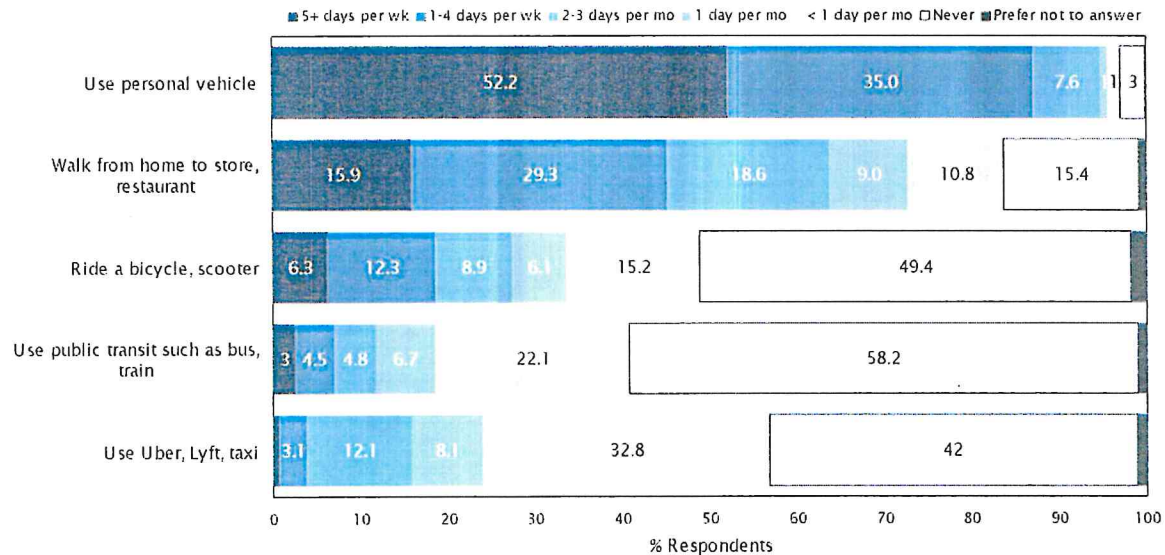
- Low time & dollar investment
