A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MATEO
TERMINATING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on January 2, 2023, the City Manager as the Director of Emergency Services issued a proclamation declaring the existence of a local emergency within the City of San Mateo, finding that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the City were caused by recent significant wet weather events, including flooding and storms, commencing on or about 3:00 a.m. on the 31st day of December 2022, at which time the City Council of the City of San Mateo was not in session; and,

WHEREAS, on January 3, 2023, said proclamation was ratified by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril is now deemed to be within the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of and within the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of San Mateo does hereby proclaim the termination of said local emergency, as of March 3, 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this action is not a project subject to CEQA, because it is an organizational or administrative activity that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5).)
