Good afternoon Laurie,

Thank you for your email – the email will be distributed to the Planning Commission for their consideration at tomorrow’s Public Hearing.

Our environmental review document identifies a former gas station in the project’s northwest corner (effectively the southeast corner of Concar Drive and S. Delaware Street). This station was demolished in 2005 and was deemed a “closed” leaking underground storage tank case with the County of San Mateo in 2013. The contractor will still need to follow protocols soil excavation to avoid a release of hazardous materials to the environment during construction.

I hope this helps clarify – let me know if I should elaborate further on this topic.
