SUBJECT:

California Library Literacy Services Family Literacy Grant – Budget Appropriation

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution to approve a supplemental budget appropriation in the amount of \$45,000 for a grant awarded by the California State Library to the San Mateo Public Library to support family literacy services.

BACKGROUND:

In June 2018, the California State Legislature approved \$2.5 million annually for California Library Literacy Services. The funds are earmarked for improving the quality and reach of existing family literacy activities, development new family literacy programming and services, and achieving the California Library Literacy Services mission to enable Californians of all ages to reach their literacy goals and use library services effectively. The San Mateo Public Library's grant application for fiscal year 2020-21 resulted in an award of \$45,000, which will be used to strengthen the library's capacity to deliver high-quality family literacy services to low-literate adults and their families; help low-literate adults develop confidence and skills in supporting their children's education; and create opportunities for families to develop a culture of positive learning experiences together on a more sustained basis.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Once appropriated, the grant funds will augment the Library's General Fund expense accounts for literacy services. There is no net impact to the General Fund for accepting and appropriating these grant funds.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

This item is not a project subject to CEQA, because it is a government fiscal activity which does not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment. (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4).)
