100% Zero Emission Vehicle Sales in California by 2030 – Resolution of Support

### RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution declaring the City's support for the goal of reaching 100% zero emission vehicle sales in California by 2030 and urging Governor Gavin Newsom, the State Legislature, and the California Air Resources Board to adopt the 100% zero emission vehicle standard by 2030 to meet greenhouse gas emissions.

### BACKGROUND:

The 100% Zero Emission Vehicle Sales in California by 2030 (ZEV2030) campaign is being initiated by a coalition of organizations and local governments committed to the implementation of a zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) standard in California by 2030. The mission is to advance the goal of 100% of new vehicle sales by 2030 in California as zero emission vehicles. The goal is focused on new car sales of light utility vehicles (e.g., passenger cars, small utility vehicles, and trucks). Several cities and jurisdictions have already adopted the ZEV2030 pledge, including the City of Oakland, City of San Leandro, City of Hayward, City of Berkeley, City of Richmond, City of Mountain View, City of Culver City, East Bay Community Energy, and MCE (formally known as Marin Clean Energy). The proposed resolution expresses support for the state's transition to 100% ZEVs and further recommends an accelerated timeline to reach this goal by 2030.

### BUDGET IMPACT:

There will not be a direct fiscal impact with respect to vehicle purchases.

### ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

This resolution is not a project subject to CEQA, because it is an organizational or administrative activity that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5).)
