New Commission Representative for Civic Arts Committee

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Planning Commission nominate a representative to the Civic Arts Committee

BACKGROUND:

As part of the Art in Public Places ordinance approved in July 2005, the Civic Arts Committee (CAC) was established in 2008. As outlined in the Chapter 23.60.020 of the municipal code, the CAC is comprised of one ex-officio member of the City Council, one member of the Planning Commission nominated by the Planning Commission, one representative of the business community nominated by the Chamber of Commerce, an architect nominated by the local chapter of the American Institute of Architects, a member of City Arts nominated by that organization, and a professional in an arts related field also nominated by City Arts. All members of the CAC are to be appointed by the City Council.

The Planning Commission's current representative is Chair Ramiro Maldonado, who was appointed by the City Council in November 2018. Chair Maldonado has indicated he would like to relinquish this role and allow another member to represent the Commission on the CAC. Thus, staff is requesting that the Planning Commission nominate a new representative to fill this role. This nomination would then be formally confirmed by the City Council.
