School Crossing Guards 2022-23 – Agreement

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve an agreement with the San Mateo-Foster City School District for school crossing guards in the amount of \$78,000 and authorize the Chief of Police to execute the agreement in substantially the form presented.

BACKGROUND:

The annual agreement between the City of San Mateo and the San Mateo-Foster City School District for school crossing guards expires on June 30, 2022. The proposed agreement for 2022-23 is included with this report as Attachment 1 and continues the City's contribution not to exceed \$78,000 towards the cost of crossing guard positions to support the safety of San Mateo children. Crossing guards are paid \$16.20 per hour as detailed in Exhibit A and will increase per the Consumer Price Index (CPI) effective January 1, 2023.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The Police Department has budgeted for this amount in the proposed 2022-23 budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

This school crossing guard agreement is not a project subject to CEQA, because it can be seen with certainty that it will not cause a physical change in the environment. (Public Resources Code Section 21065.)
