SUBJECT:

Board and Commission Appointment Subcommittee – Senior Citizens Commission

RECOMMENDATION:

Appoint Mayor Rick Bonilla and Council Member Joe Goethals to the Senior Citizens Commission Appointment Subcommittee.

BACKGROUND:

On November 27, 2021 an unscheduled vacancy occurred on the Senior Citizens Commission due to the passing of Irene Bluth. The Council had an established eligibility list from the last recruitment and on January 18, 2022 Council appointed Jon Wu to the partial term ending June 10, 2025. Jun Wu stepped down before serving due to the residency requirement not being met. The eligibility list is exhausted; and the Appointment Subcommittee needs to be re-established.

Per the City Council Guidelines, the City Council appoints an appointment subcommittee for each board or commission body, comprised of the Mayor (or designee) and the Council liaison to that commission. The guidelines also allow the other Council members to participate as a member of the appointment subcommittee. In order to ensure that the meeting appropriately noticed and agendaized, this is the opportunity for Council to add their names as a participant to the appointment subcommittee.

BUDGET IMPACT:

There is no budget impact with this action.
