SUBJECT:

November 8, 2022 Statewide Propositions - Recommendations

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the Legislative Committee's recommendations to take the following positions on the propositions on the ballot for the November 8, 2022 Statewide General Election: Proposition 28 (Funding Arts and Music Education) – Support; and Proposition 31 (Prohibiting Retail Sale of Certain Flavored Tobacco Products) – Support.

BACKGROUND:

On September 29, 2022, the Legislative Committee comprised of the Mayor and Deputy Mayor met to consider recommending positions on the November 8, 2022 General Election. There are seven propositions on the ballot. City Council passed a Resolution in Support of Proposition 1 on September 19, 2022. As such, the Legislative Committee discussed the remaining six propositions.

After discussion, the Legislative Committee recommended the City Council take a support position on Proposition 28 and Proposition 31. City Council may wish to note that the Legislative Committee reached a split vote on Proposition 29 (one neutral and one support), which relates to kidney dialysis clinics requirements.

Attachment 1 provides Council with a summary of each proposition.
