General Municipal Election November 8, 2022 - Certification of Results

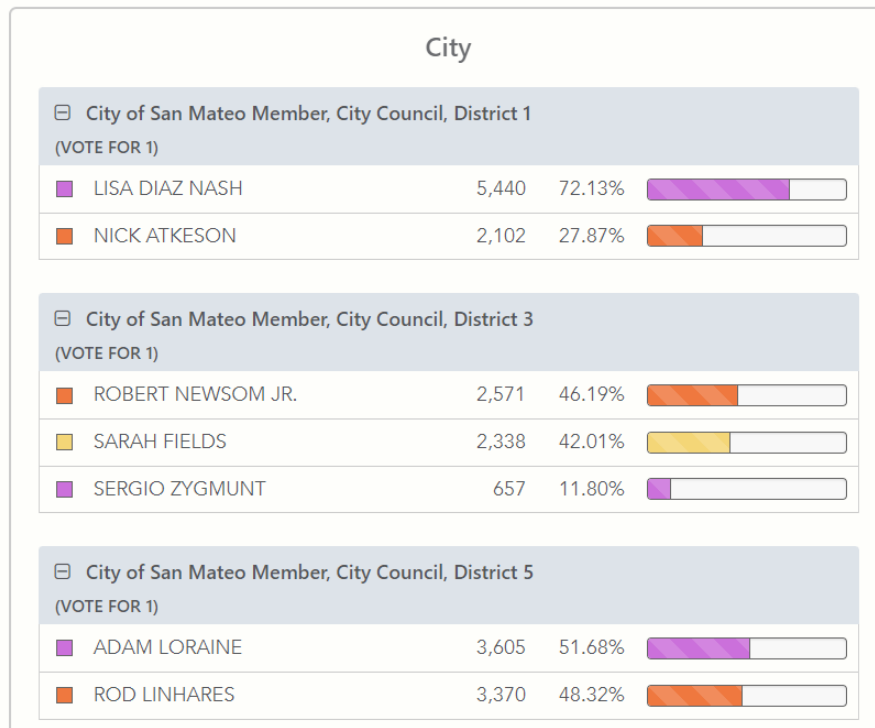
### RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution to declare the results of the General Municipal Election held on November 8, 2022 as presented in the Certificate and Statement of Results of Votes Cast for the City of San Mateo.

### BACKGROUND:

The City of San Mateo held its first candidate by-district election for Districts 1, 3, and 5 on November 8, 2022; and for submitting to the voters Measure CC - to Increase Existing Real Property Transfer Tax Rate for Properties Sold for \$10 Million or More.

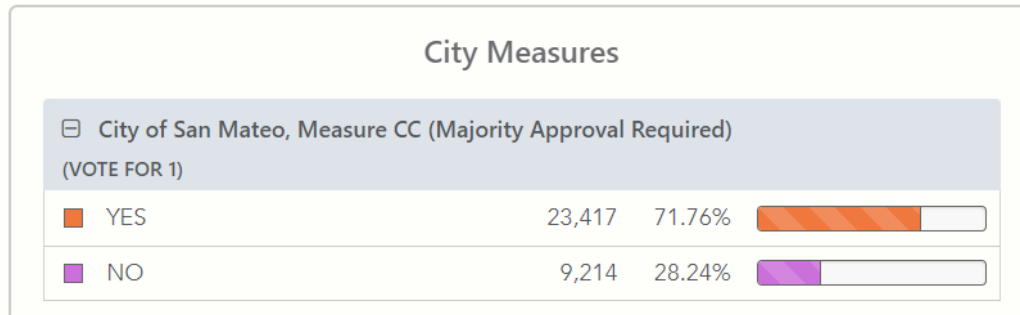
The semi-official results show the following for the three candidate races as of Monday, November 28, 2022:



The number of ballots cast for each district as of 11/28/2022 are:

District 1 .....	8,945
District 3 .....	6,690
District 5 .....	8,409

The semi-official results show the following for Measure CC:



The number of ballots cast citywide for the ballot measure were 34,576. The ordinance approving Measure CC was therefore adopted by the voters on November 8, 2022 and will go into effect ten days after certification of election results.

The official results showing the Statement of Votes Cast will be contained in Exhibit A to the resolution (Attachment 1) upon receipt from the County of San Mateo. The County has 30 days, until December 8, 2022, to provide the certification. If the final results are not received in time for this December 5, 2022 meeting, the City Council will be asked to pass the semi-official results and will take action at the special December 12, 2022 meeting to adopt a revised resolution with final results.

#### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

The City Clerk has budget of \$213,500 to cover costs of this election. It is not anticipated that additional funding will be necessary.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:**

This resolution of adoption of the election results is not a project subject to CEQA, because it is an organizational or administrative activity that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5).)
