Citywide Street Rehabilitation Package 4-B Project – Agreement

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve an agreement with G. Bortolotto & Company for the Citywide Street Rehabilitation Package 4-B Project in the amount of \$2,984,056.50; establish a contingency reserve in the amount of \$300,000; and authorize the Public Works Director to execute the agreement in substantially the form presented and issue change orders within the amount of the contingency amount.

BACKGROUND:

The Citywide Street Rehabilitation Package 4-B Project (Project) is part of the Public Works Pavement Management Program (Program). The Project will repair approximately 2.2 miles of streets across eight locations with an Engineer's Estimate for the Project of \$3,300,000. Project locations are shown in the Location Map (Attachment 3).

The Project was advertised on May 2, 2023, and a total of five (5) bids were received and opened on June 1, 2023. The bids received are listed below in order of increasing bid amount.

G. Bortolotto & Company, Inc.	\$2,984,056.50
Roadway Construction	\$3,213,230.00
Interstate Grading & Paving	\$3,506,442.50
O'Grady Paving	\$3,590,929.00
Granite Construction	\$4,876,105.00

After review of bid documents, staff determined that G. Bortolotto & Company, Inc. is the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. Therefore, staff recommends G. Bortolotto & Company, Inc. be awarded this construction agreement.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Sufficient funds are available in the Citywide Street Rehabilitation Package III (467009) project budget to award this agreement.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

This Project is categorically exempt from CEQA as an "existing facility," because it consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use. (CEQA Guidelines Section 15301.)
