25th Avenue Grade Separation - Project Update

RECOMMENDATION:
Receive an update from Caltrain staff on the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project.

BACKGROUND:
The 25th Avenue Grade Separation project raises the tracks at the 25th Avenue crossing, which will allow east-west street connections at 28th and 31st Avenues in conformance with the Bay Meadows Transit Oriented Development Plan. The Hillsdale Caltrain Station will also be relocated northward between 28th and 31st Avenues as part of these improvements. Construction of the project kicked off in early 2018 and is estimated to be completed mid-late 2020.

Caltrain staff will provide an update to the Sustainability and Infrastructure (S&I) Commission on the current progress of construction 25th Avenue Grade Separation project and the impacts on Caltrain operations caused by construction activity. The project team has been providing project updates for the 25th Avenue Grade Separation on a regular basis at key milestones.

This update will focus on the following items:

- Construction activities that have caused significant delay to the anticipated project completion and current schedule.
- Cost and budget
- Caltrain operational service disruption and modification necessary due to the required construction activities.
