SUBJECT:
School Crossing Guard 2019-20 Agreement

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve an agreement with the San Mateo-Foster City School District for school crossing guards in an amount not to exceed \$78,000 and authorize the Chief of Police to execute the agreement in substantially the form presented.

BACKGROUND:

The annual agreement between the City of San Mateo and the San Mateo-Foster City School District for school crossing guards will expire on June 30, 2019. The proposed agreement for 2019-20 is included with this report as Attachment 1. It is City policy that inter-governmental agreements be approved by the City Council.

In past years, the City has contributed an amount not to exceed \$66,000 towards the cost of 14 crossing guard positions to support the safety of San Mateo children. Staff recommends increasing the not-to-exceed amount to \$78,000 to comply with the City's minimum wage requirements. This increased cap represents the current minimum wage and an estimate of the CPI increase taking effect on January 1, 2020. Crossing guards are currently paid \$15.00 per hour as detailed in Exhibit A.

BUDGET IMPACT:

This cost for this program is included in the Police Department's proposed operating budget for FY 2019-20.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

This action is not a project subject to CEQA, because it can be seen with certainty that it will not cause a physical change in the environment. (Public Resources Code Section 21065.)
