SUBJECT:

Transit Oriented Development Pedestrian Access Study - Grant Application

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve a letter of support to the San Mateo City/County Association of Governments for Transit Oriented Development Pedestrian Access Study grant application to improve pedestrian access to transit stations, and authorize the Mayor to sign the letter on behalf of the City Council.

BACKGROUND:

The Legislative Committee met on July 9th to discuss the letter of support for the City of San Mateo's Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 grant application for the Transit Oriented Development Pedestrian Access Study. The study would evaluate deficiencies in pedestrian access in a one-half mile radius of the City's three Caltrain stations to create safe and comfortable walking routes for all ages and abilities to access transit. As such, the Legislative Committee recommends the City Council support the grant application by submitting the attached letter to the San Mateo City/County Association of Governments (C/CAG).

BUDGET IMPACT:

There is no budget impact for submitting a letter supporting the grant application.
